Recommended perennials for basic landscaping for the Community:

- Golden Thread
- Kings Golden Cypress
- Bayberry
- Soft-touch Holly
- Dwarf Alberta Spruce
- Variegated Euonymus
- Dwarf Fountain Grass

Note that this list is suggested as the basic foundation to achieve visual continuity throughout our community. The goal is to achieve overall property value enhancement.

In spring and fall, owners may add annuals among the perennials, but flowering annuals will not be replacing the space for perennials. The object is to have greenery and color year-round within the community.

Owners should plan to remove older, overgrown perennials that are blocking doors, windows and walkways. They could be replaced with the above at owner's expense.

In all cases, any replacement plantings must be of the approved species and replacement approved by the Landscaping Committee (after consultation with our Landscaper, Forever Green.) Purchase and installation of an approved planting is at Owner's expense.
